After last years events we have moved venues for this year. We have moved to Mark Hall School in Harlow. The school is on the main A414 and is 5 minutes from the M11. It is very spacious and has 4 large halls.

As the feis is close to the All Ireland we have specified that we will be doing the light round first.

Due to timetabling constraints we are unable to have the usual 'step down the line' in both rounds. To enable some practice we will still have a recall step down the line in the Heavy Round where there are more than 10 dancers (All Ireland Age Groups only).

Every grade competition will start with the Heavy Jig (except Under 6 & Under 7).

There will be an extensive range of food available, both hot & cold and the canteen will open before the first competition both days.

As of last year, we are also going to repeat the pioneering idea of not charging a door entry fee. This involves a one-off payment of £6 per family for all members of the same family covering the whole weekend. This payment should be made alongside the competition entry. Numbers will be withheld if no payment is received, but can be collected on the day of the feis upon payment of the £6.

RULES

1. Ages to be taken from 1st January 2009
2. The feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha
3. The receipt of entries implies that you acknowledge and accept all of the rules set down by An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha & the Southern England Regional Council as well as the additional rules listed below.
4. Entries will only be accepted from teachers registered with An Coimisiun.
5. 'Beginners Rule' the basic steps as defined by the Southern England Regional Council will be adhered to for all Beginners age groups.
6. Beginners & Primary Grade competitions are confined to the Southern England region only.
7. A dancer may only compete in one grade for each dance.
8. An Coimisiun ruled that as from 01/09/08, that no block, en pointe, stationary or moving be allowed to be performed for all ages up to & including the under 11 age group.
9. Dancers should have proof of age (i.e. Registration cards) in the event of a query into their age group.
10. Where there are 5 dancers or less for Beginners, Primary & Intermediate competitions the results will not affect their grading.
11. A Beginner is a dancer who has never gained a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in the Beginner grade or any medal in a higher grade for that particular dance.
12. A Primary dancer is one whom has never won 1st or 2nd place for that particular dance in any age group.
13. An Intermediate dancer is one whom has not won 1st place for that particular dance in a particular age group and/or has not won an Open or Preliminary Championship or Premier competition.
14. Any Beginners, Primary & Intermediate competition in which competitor's number over 40 competitors will be split evenly by number.
15. All Championship Cups are perpetual; winners will be responsible for any loss or damage and for their safe return in adequate time for the next Feisanna.
16. All adjudicator's decisions are **FINAL**.
17. Any competitions can be moved to another hall at the discretion of Feis Secretary.
18. No entries will be taken on the day.
19. Dancers must be properly attired throughout the whole competition and in the halls, as well as for the results ceremony.
20. No smoking in any of the schools buildings.
21. In all heavy dances for Intermediate & Open the lead round must be danced on both right & left feet.
22. The Feis committee accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to any personal property.
23. Objections against any breach of the rules must be made in writing and signed by a TCRG to the Feis Secretary & accompanied by a fee of £25. This will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
24. Any form of unauthorised photography, video or digital recording that has the capability to capture a dancer's image is expressly forbidden whilst competitions are in progress.
25. The dancers will remain in the same order for each round of the championships.
26. A recall in the Premier competition or championships will be at the discretion of the adjudicators and the organising committee. All dancers will dance their Set Dances if there are less than 10 dancers competing.
27. Makeup will not be permitted for any dancer in the first 2 grades up to & including the Under 12 age group.

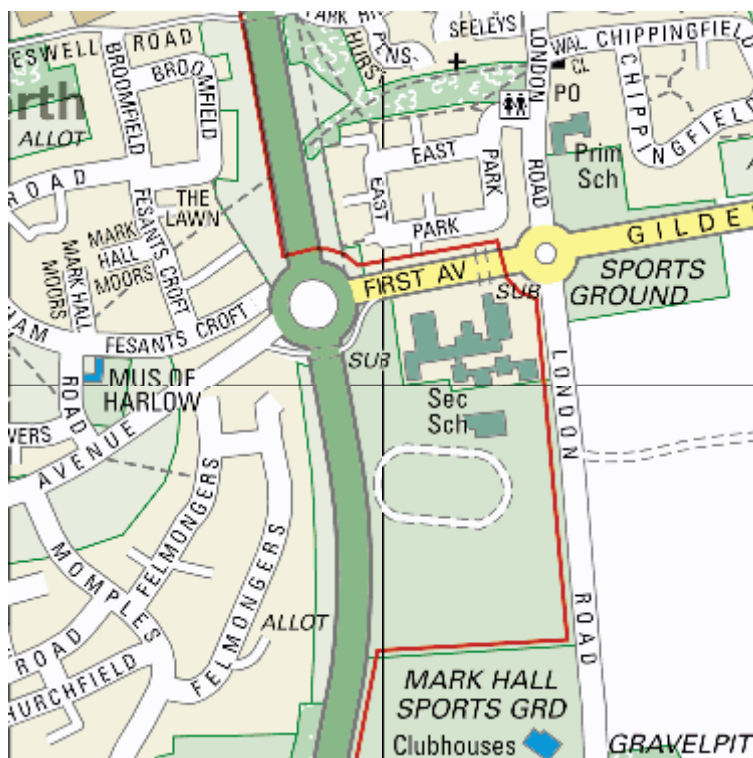
DIRECTIONS

Come off the M11 at junction 7. Take the 4th exit towards Harlow on the A414. Keep on the A414 going over 3 roundabouts. At the 4th roundabout take the 3rd exit onto First Avenue towards to Hatfield Heath. The school is directly on the right.

FROM SOUTH

Go on the M11 at end of North Circular Road (A406). Come off the M11 at junction 7. Take the 2nd exit towards Harlow on the A414. Keep on the A414 going over 3 roundabouts. At the 4th roundabout take the 3rd exit onto First Avenue towards to Hatfield Heath. The school is directly on the right.
